

Grantee Connect Series Summary

JANUARY 2025

In 2024, Cuyahoga Arts & Culture created a series of opportunities for CAC-funded nonprofits to connect with CAC and each other. This included a variety of approaches to build trust-based relationships with our grantee partners, and to best position CAC to respond to their needs and the residents they serve.

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BACKGROUND



Cuyahoga Arts & Culture (CAC) is the public funder of arts and cultural organizations in Cuyahoga County, Ohio and a political subdivison of the State of Ohio charted in Ohio Revised Code Section 3381. Since 2006, CAC has made over 4,300 grants totaling \$257 million to 500 nonprofits. Every year, CAC-funded nonprofits offer millions of cultural experiences.

In November 2023, CAC committed to listening more deeply and connecting with our nonprofit arts and cultural community to help shape our grantmaking. This commitment was made at a difficult time for our arts community. Many nonprofit organizations were continuing to grapple with uncertainties and budgetary constraints resulting from the pandemic. CAC made a difficult decision to proceed with planned reductions to its grantmaking allocation as its own revenue continued to decline. Listening and evaluation have always been core to CAC's grantmaking process. However, we acknowledged that work needed to be done to build trust and unity so that CAC remains responsive to the needs of our grantee partners and residents, now and into the future.

CAC is funded by a tax on cigarettes sold in Cuyahoga County, Ohio. **Cigarette smoking rates have changed drastically since Cuyahoga Arts & Culture's inception.** As CAC's sole funding source, the tax on cigarettes sold in Cuyahoga County, Ohio has decreased by more than 50 percent since 2007. The tax does not include sales of vapes, marijuana, or other tobacco products. Levied at the rate of 1½ cents or 15 mills per cigarette (30 cents per pack) from 2007-2025, the tax has generated substantial funding.

The successful passage of Issue 55 in November 2024 was an important step forward. Issue 55 expands the tax to 35 mills (3½ cents) per cigarette. CAC will start to receive the increased tax revenues in March 2025 and anticipates new revenue will impact grants made for 2026 and beyond. This expanded levy ensures funding for local arts nonprofits through 2035.

As we look ahead to CAC's next decade, we must ask: **how do we continue to strengthen our arts and cultural nonprofits – to the benefit of all County residents – for years to come?** The Grantee Connect Series is a crucial part of beginning to answer that question – starting with the people, and organizations, CAC supports.

BACKGROUND



The Grantee Connect Series offered staff and board members at CAC-funded organizations multiple ways to help shape CAC's work:

- **1. Independent and Anonymous Grantee Survey:** a comprehensive, anonymous survey about CAC's grantmaking and future, managed by an independent research firm.
- **2. Grantee Connect Meetups:** a series of in-person and virtual gatherings to hear the initial survey findings, share feedback, and connect with peers.

CAC also conducted a **National Scan of Local & State Arts Funders** and collected **Guidelines Feedback** to inform our work:

- CAC scanned nine other arts and culture funders using public funds across the country. The resulting data include a high-level summary of grantmaking strategies used by peer funders, organized into key themes and individual funder profiles.
- As it does each year, CAC provides an opportunity for real-time feedback on CAC's grantmaking guidelines. During this process, grantee partners reviewed and submitted a comment form on the 2025 Project Support grant guidelines, which directly resulted in changes to streamline and simplify the materials and provided context for future planning work.

All of CAC's planning efforts build off the agency's multi-year planning and evaluation processes, including Cuyahoga Voices & Vision (<u>future.cacgrants.org</u>), a community listening and planning process. This was conducted in 2016 following the completion of CAC's first – and start of its second – 10-year tax levy cycle.

METHODOLOGY



2024 Grantee Connect Survey

On behalf of Cuyahoga Arts & Culture (CAC), Bedrock Research, LLC conducted a survey to establish a baseline of grantee feedback to help shape future planning and build grantee confidence as CAC enters the levy process. Specifically:

- Take a temperature of grantees on various grantmaking related topical issues
- Establish a baseline for grantee satisfaction with elements of the grant process
- Understand areas where grantees might need additional support / resources
- Build good will with grantees by seeking honest feedback
- Inform 2024 staff work; improve processes for 2025, identify issues/opportunities for 2026
- Serve as a precursor to further listening/assessment

Methods/Collection of Data

The 2024 Survey of CAC Grantees was administered online by Bedrock Research, LLC. CAC provided Bedrock with a list of contacts for 2023 grantees who are also 2024 grantees. For some organizations more than one contact was provided.

Data were collected between March 21, 2024, and April 23, 2024. Respondents were invited to participate in the survey via an email invitation. A total of 376 grantee contacts were invited to participate in the survey from 247 organizations.

An initial pre-survey email was sent by CAC to eligible grantees explaining the purpose of the survey and alerting them to expect an email from Bedrock with a survey link. Bedrock sent four separate emails to eligible grantees, an initial invitation and three reminders. CAC also sent one additional email reminding grantees to please complete the survey. As an incentive for participation grantees were eligible to enter a drawing to win one of five \$75 gift cards. A total of 218 completed surveys were received from 185 organizations, resulting in a 58% response rate at the individual participant level and a **75% response rate at the organization level**.

CAC was provided aggregated survey data results and masked verbatim comments to protect respondent anonymity.

METHODOLOGY



2024 Grantee Connect Meetups

CAC invited Staff and Board members at current and recent grantee organizations to participate in the Grantee Connect Meetups, held in June 2024. The purpose of the Grantee Connect Meetups was to **utilize in-person gatherings to foster connections between CAC and grantee partners, and to share the results of the survey.**

Four Grantee Connect Meetups were hosted in-person at grantee organizations, and one was hosted online. 70 attendees representing 59 organizations participated. The sessions were led by CAC, beginning with a presentation of initial survey findings and leading to a broader discussion among participants about their experiences with CAC funding and what they hope to see from CAC in the future. Conversation topics ranged from large-scale planning, such as grant allocation planning, to smaller details like word counts in applications. After the session, participants were encouraged to continue providing feedback and given the link to CAC's online feedback form.

KEY FINDINGS



Response and Initial Findings

More than **280 individual participants** representing over **200 grantee partner organizations** participated in the Grantee Connect Series. Most of the participation came through the survey, which saw a 75% organizational response rate (185 grantee partner organizations) and a 58% individual response rate (218 completed surveys).

CAC staff held Grantee Connect Meetups at five locations, and in one online session. At those sessions we shared initial findings from the survey and gathered additional feedback.

The findings include:

- 1. Grant recipients highly value consistent multi-year and flexible funding from CAC.
- 2. Grantee partners are **satisfied with communications about the grantmaking process** and find CAC staff helpful.
- 3. Some grant recipients do not understand how their grants are determined.
- 4. There is **confusion about CAC's role in fundraising** and/or diversifying revenues.
- 5. There is **not consensus on how CAC should distribute funds** or evolve its grantmaking, despite a shared need for more resources at an organizational level (meaning each organization needs money).

KEY FINDINGS



Importance of Flexible Funding

Participants across all grant programs emphasized the importance of multi-year commitments and flexible operating funds. Currently, all three of CAC's grant programs provide multi-year funding opportunities and aim to be as flexible as possible.

"I appreciate that as a repeat grantee we could just reapply for same or similar actions this year. Anything you can do to help us small organizations continue our work and help us grow would also be appreciated."

"By providing stable annual operating support, our CAC grants allowed our staff to focus on details of programs, developing relationships with partners, evaluation, capacity building and marketing."

Consistent multi-year commitments and flexible funding are highly valued by our grantee partners and continue to be a priority for CAC.



Communications and Grantmaking Process


Grantee partners are satisfied with communications about the grantmaking process and find grant managers helpful. On this topic, CAC received a positive response, with top box selections at 90% or higher.

I receive enough deadline reminders to help me submit applications and reports to CAC on time.

My grant manager has been helpful in answering questions when they come up.

CAC provides clear information about grant cycles, requirements, and timelines.

I received clear communications about changes to my grant amount between 2023 and 2024.




CAC strives to be clear and transparent in its communication with grantee partners. Organizations find the process easy to navigate and can rely on their grant managers for assistance.



Grant Calculations

Some grant recipients reported that they do not understand how their grants are calculated, leaving room for improvement.



There is room for improvement in our communication about grant amount calculations. Formulas across grant programs are complex and rely on several factors other than an organization's own revenue.

KEY FINDINGS



CAC's Role in Fundraising

There is confusion about CAC's role in fundraising and/or diversifying its revenues. Many participants commented that CAC should diversify or increase its revenue through fundraising or other methods.

"CAC should diversify revenue streams."

"I would like CAC to look for other ways to supplement the declining funds."

"Now that marijuana is legal, can CAC receive funding from the tax on marijuana?"

"Those last few questions were frustrating. The answer, I think, is to identify new revenue streams."

"Research and adopt new revenue models so that CAC is less reliant on 'sin tax' funding."

CAC's primary role is to steward the dollars collected by the tax. While we can accept funds from other sources, it is not common for governments to have a fundraising arm or be in competition with our grantee partners. CAC works closely with organizations that have a mission of advocacy, including but not limited to Americans for the Arts, Creative Ohio, and Assembly for the Arts.



Distribution of CAC Funds

There is not consensus on how CAC should distribute funds or evolve its grantmaking, despite a shared need for more resources at an organizational level. When asked if CAC should allocate more funds to General Operating Support or Project Support grants, responses were almost evenly split. Grantee partners also disagree on solutions to accommodate the increasing number of applications and decreasing amount of funding available.


In 2024, more than 80% of CAC's grantmaking budget goes to General Operating Support grants. The remainder goes to project-based grants for nonprofits.

In the future. CAC should consider:



As anticipated, CAC receives decreasing tax revenue each year (down 50% since CAC's inception). At the same time, CAC receives increasing numbers of applications each year.

How should CAC's grantmaking process best accommodate this?



CAC works to find solutions that align with the needs of our grantee partners, but those needs often differ across grant programs and organizations sizes. There is no one-size-fits-all approach to our grantmaking.

TAKING ACTION



Takeaways for CAC: Continuing the Conversation

We have already begun acting on what we heard. For example, the survey indicated grantee partners are generally satisfied with communications from CAC. However, we heard grantee partners might benefit from new approaches to sharing information about CAC and its processes through videos, visual aids, and other tools. In August 2024, we released a new Communications Toolkit to help grantees share information about CAC.

We also commit to:

- Continue the conversation CAC will continue its Grantee Connect Meetups, as an ongoing space to build trust and connection between CAC and the groups it funds.
- Offer ongoing feedback mechanisms CAC has launched a general feedback form to collect feedback from grantee partners and the public on a year-round basis. CAC has also increased its grantee site visits in 2024 and will continue to prioritize a variety of opportunities to connect with staff. In 2024, the grants team conducted more than 100 visits, an increase over recent years.
- Leverage the research and findings for Board planning CAC will use the scan and related data to inform discussion among its Board of Trustees as it considers the best ways to support arts and cultural nonprofits in 2026 and beyond.
